Health Care and Public Safety

More than 90% of the state’s general fund goes directly to education, healthcare, and public safety. At the same time, Oregon’s corporate minimum income tax hasn’t been changed since 1931. For years, two-thirds of the corporations doing business in Oregon have paid **only \$10** in the corporate minimum tax.

It’s time to do what’s right for Oregon. The recession has hit Oregon hard. Measures 66 & 67 protect those who have been hit hardest by this crisis – seniors, children, and the unemployed – and protect the middle class from paying more. Under these measures, big corporations and the richest households will pay just a little more, but if your family earns less than \$250,000 a year, you won’t pay a penny more. By **voting YES on Measures 66 & 67**, we can preserve essential services like K-12 education, in-home care for seniors, and the Oregon Health Plan.

Now we need your help. Wall Street banks and corporate lobbyists are trying to overturn these measures. If Measures 66 & 67 defeated, it will result in nearly \$1 billion in cuts which will come from education, healthcare, and public safety.
